Candidate Interviews and Offer of Employment

SUMMARY: This is a placeholder to provide a monthly update on activities related to the Executive Director search.

RECOMMENDATION. Motion to approve an offer of employment.

DISCUSSION

The Board will be interviewing three Candidates on August 2, 2024. At the conclusion of the interviews the Board Members will be given a "straw poll" – a written ballot to nominate their first choice for the Executive Director. Once a clear leader emerges, the Board will be asked to make a motion to offer employment to that individual.

Salary is set by the Board. The Search Committee advertised the anticipated hiring range to be \$100,000 - \$120,000. The prior incumbent was hired in 2019 at \$101,000. Her final salary was \$112,528, plus she received \$250 per month car allowance and ordinary benefits. \$115,000 is programmed into the budget; however, with staff turnover, there is flexibility in salary.

Final arrangements. A draft offer letter is attached. It is possible there could be some additional negotiations once the offer is extended. An Executive Committee meeting is scheduled for August 9th, if necessary to finalize the arrangements.

Other. Please refer to your prior copies of Candidate resumes and personality profiles. Staff will have extra copies available if needed. Background checks are currently underway.
