The Nominating Committee met on September 20, 2024 at 10:00am. The Board of Directors has encouraged members and officers to renew their commitments for the purpose of maintaining a smoot transition for the incoming Executive Director.

Reappointment of At-Large Directors. During the last Board of Directors meeting, each of the at-large directors on expiring terms stated they would be glad to serve again. A question was raised as to whether a public notice would be necessary in this set of circumstances. Appointments are governed by Article II of the Business Development Board (BDB) Bylaws. BDB attorney Ken Norman reviewed the BDB Bylaws and determined there is no need to give public notice of the reappointment of at-large directors.
