SUMMARY: This item provides the monthly financial reports.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. Motion to receive the reports.

Discussion

The September reports require two important qualifiers:

- 1. September should be considered preliminary, and subject to possible further accounting and/or auditing adjustments.
- 2. The monthly reports are produced on a "cash basis" to produce a clearer picture of actual cash on hand, as the Board currently prefers. Auditing and annual reports will be prepared on an "accrual basis" which will result is some differences. "Accrual" is an accounting term which means that it includes revenue which has been invoiced but not yet received, and expenses for goods and services which have not yet been received.

Overview of reports

- 1. Balance Sheet.
 - a. Bank accounts are reconciled by the independent accounting firm Gelinas Group.
 - b. Note the line item "Prepaid Expenses" in the amount of \$7,000. This is for an annual subscription for site selector software which was paid prior to September 30th. This is an example of a "cash" transaction which will be "accrued" to the new fiscal year.
- 2. Budget v Actual. Please note the following comments:
 - a. Income. As noted previously, both Investor Income and Sponsorship Income were budgeted on an "aspirational" basis in the current year.
 - b. Outside Services. Outside services is tracking high due to staff turnover and corresponding use of contractual relationships.
 - c. Payroll budget is below estimate, also due to staff vacancies.
 - d. Technology Communications. Continues to be over budget due to budget starting too low.
 - e. Unapplied Cash Bill Payment Expense. This refers to the \$7,000 payment mentioned on the balance sheet.
- 3. Statement of Activities Prior Month. Note the \$7,000 payment was made in September.
- 4. Statement of Activities Quarterly. Comments are similar to above.
